



# 2024 General Elections Complaint

Any member of the KPU Community is permitted to submit a written complaint within the Complaint Period (up to 72 hours following the end of voting). Since the voting period ends Thursday, February 15th, 2024 at 6:30pm, complaints may be submitted until Sunday, February 18th, 2024 at 6:30pm.

Complaints may be made regarding any irregularity regarding candidates or elections officials. Such irregularities must involve a real or perceived violation of the the KSA Elections Bylaws, Regulations, or policies of the Chief Returning Officer, that could impact the validity and fairness of an election. **Complaints must be submitted within 72 hours of the alleged irregularity being discovered.**

## Instructions:

1. Please complete the fields below. Anonymous complaints will not be addressed.
2. Ensure you provide the full name(s) of the Candidate(s) in question. If possible, please provide the position(s) they are running for.
3. Be concise, provide factual details and attach as much evidence as possible. Please remember to reference the particular section(s) of the KSA Bylaws and/or Regulations you believe were violated. You must also explain how you believe the violation affected the fairness or the outcome of the election.
4. Complaint forms must be submitted in person to a Member Services Specialist at a KSA office. All complaint forms after the first submitted by the same individual must include a \$20 deposit which will be refunded no later than 14 days after the final complaint deadline, unless the Chief Returning Officer deems the complaint to be frivolous or vexatious. Supporting evidence may be submitted by email to the Chief Returning Officer at [elections@kusa.ca](mailto:elections@kusa.ca).

The Chief Returning Officer may require further information, including contact information for witnesses. If these are not provided by the deadline specified by the Chief Returning Officer in the request for this information, the complaint will be adjudicated without this information, which is likely to have a negative effect on the outcome of the complaint.
